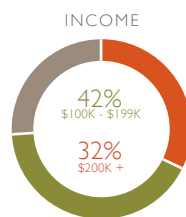
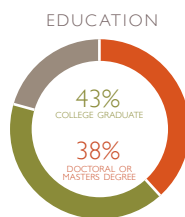
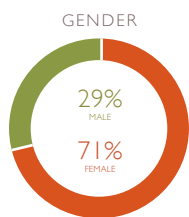
ABOUT THE CULINARY VILLAGE:
